In your email, you will receive a zip file that contains:

1. One ePub file. This is the file that you can use for your Apple, Windows, Google, and Kobo devices.

2. One Mobi file. This is the file that you can use for your Kindle devices.

Quick Steps

Transfer your Opus eBooks to your Kobo devices:

- Turn on your Kobo eReader.
- Connect your eReader to your computer using a Micro USB cable.
- On your Kobo eReader >> Tap **Connect**.
- On your computer >> Open **Adobe Digital Editions**.
- In *Adobe Digital Editions* > Under **Devices**, right-click on **Kobo eReader**.
- Click **Authorize Device**.
Tip: If you don't see 'Kobo eReader' under Devices, close Adobe Digital Editions, then open it again.
- Click **Authorize Device**.
- Click **OK** at the confirmation screen.
- Click on **File** at the top of the screen.
- Click **Add to Library**. A browse window will appear.
- Browse for the epub file:
On a PC: Click the "eBooks" drop-down menu and select > Adobe Content Server Message.
On a Mac: Click *Options*, then click *epub files*.
- Select the **epub file**, then click **Add**. The book will open.
- Click **Library** at the top-left corner of the screen to go back to the *Adobe Digital Editions* home screen.
- Click **All items**.
- Select your new book and drag it to the Kobo eReader bookshelf (listed on the left side under **Devices**).
- Eject your Kobo and unplug the Micro USB cable from your Kobo. The book will appear in your **Library**.
- To see the books you added, go to the **My Books** menu on your Kobo eReader.
- Tap **Filter** at the top of the screen, then select **Imported**.
- You'll see all the items you've added with *Adobe Digital Editions*.
